#### Purchasing

- Responsible for ordering product for all retail locations, website, and events
- Stay within the weekly purchasing budget established by the Financial Controller.
- Manage and follow through the entire PO cycle from creation to receiving and solve any issues related to quality, quantity, and on time delivery
- Ensure products are purchased at the lowest possible cost by taking advantage of monthly specials and volume discounts.
- · Maintain a purchasing calendar for each brand.
- Manage and analyze inventory ordering requirements and set/modify rules for order frequency, days of supply, and min/max's
- Identify the root causes of issues such as out-of-stocks and aged or expiring inventory through the collection and analysis of data and provide recommended solutions
